General Description

Responsible for assisting the Pacific Region Deputy Chief of Staff Aerospace Education in directing executing and monitoring the pacific region external aerospace education program.

Primary Job Functions

- Develop content for the PCR AEO-AEM Workshop, and the CAP-USAF Diversity Project.
 - This may include presentations, activities, logistics and participation
- Cultivating and maintaining professional relationships with wing and unit AEO; mentoring and
 assisting AEO's as needed when they are working with the local and state organizations, colleges,
 universities and civic institutions to promote/expand current CAP AE programs.
 - Assist with the promotion and development of aerospace education projects at the state, community and local school level (workshops, seminars, courses, material development, etc.)
 - Mentor wing and sub-ordinate unit personnel with the award nomination packet for:
 - Category III (Individual/ Organization) Brewer Memorial Award.
 - Scott Crossfield Aerospace Education Teacher of the Year Award.
- Creating and regularly updating external aerospace education presentation materials.
- Promote CAP AE materials through collaboration with the formal education structure (staff meetings, district in-service trainings, teacher classrooms, school clubs, NSTA, and Homeschool)
 - Through train the trainer instruction, presentations to units, educators and organizations inside and outside of CAP.
 - A program assessment form for each presentation will be used to evaluate and enhance the presentations.
- Promote CAP external aerospace education by developing FAQ and Best Practices along with instructional materials; to be used by CAP Units.
- Promote and participate in growing membership in the AEM program at least 10% each year.
 - o Develop communication channels to the current PCR AEM's
 - Assist as needed Wing Group and Units in the TOP Flight program
 - Be available to respond to FAQ or NHQ link questions regarding the AEM program
- Mentor or assist AEM's in the preparation and submission AFA Aerospace Educator Grant Application.
- Provide monthly report (due last working day of the month) to ORWG Director of Aerospace Education.

Travel

This position may require travel within the six states of the Pacific Region and to National HQ
activities. Transportation and room cost will be covered if there are funds in the Pacific Region
Aerospace Education Budget.

Required skills

- Have at least a Senior Rating in AE CAPP 215 program.
- Have at least a Technician Rating in the Cadet CAPP 216 program
- Be familiar with CAP regulations in the 50, 76 and 280 series.
- Be familiar with all aerospace education material described in the CAP Bookstore Catalog and the HQ CAP/ETA publication entitled "Aerospace Education Teaching Materials."
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint)
- Knowledge of PREZI
- Adept at public speaking and can provide a professional presentation
- Adheres to the CAP Uniform standards as outlined in CAPR 39.3 and exhibit professional demeanor representative of CAP personnel.
